RULES: I.J.F. rules and Judo Québec general tournament rules.

FORMULE: U8 no shiai. Ground Randori, continuous running time, no score or winner all participants receive the

same award.

U10 white: No shiai. Ground Randori, continuous running time, no score or winner, all participants

receive the same award.

U10 yellow and orange: by pool (priority 3 to 4 participants). Boys and girls are separated but could be grouped with parent permission or in the absence of parent, the coach with a parent consent form can authorize the grouping to maximize athlete participation (see document to fill). Standing randori, , continuous running time, no score or winner, all participants receive the same award.

U12 by pool (priority 3 to 4 participants). Note U12 tournaments are no longer mixed, genders are necessarily separated.

U12 are grouped together first by weight then by belt in the following manner.

Yellow belts fight yellow belts, yellow-orange or orange.

Orange belts can fight yellow belts and above.

U14 and above modified double elimination (pool if the number of athletes is not sufficient for modified double elimination).

U21/Senior by pool (priority 3 to 4 participants) with closest weight (with a maximum ratio of 15%

difference).

START TIME: Sunday January 28 2024: U8, U10, U12 start at 9h30

U14, U16, U18, U21/senior, not before 10h30

FIGHT DURATION: U8: 2 minutes continuous time

U10: 2 minutes continuous time

U12: 2 minutes U14, U16: 3 minutes U18, U21/Senior 4 minutes

JUDOGIS: White judgoi required for all. Blue or reversible white/blue permitted when called in second.

AWARDS: Medals, as per Judo Québec tournament rules.
